### The role of the governing board

### The role of a parent governor

- The specific skills required to make sure the governing board delivers effective governance

### Expectations of governors

Make sure candidates fully understand what is expected of them in their role by outlining your expectations, including:

- Attendance at meetings
- Maintaining confidentiality
- Committing to training
- Visiting the school
- Their term of office

If we receive more applications than there are vacancies, a secret ballot will be carried out. We will inform you closer to the time if we have to do this.




