Y1 Partnership Sports Day

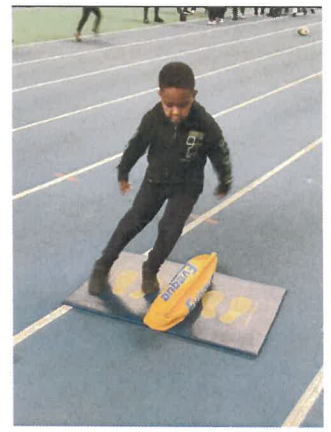
