Uniform

Parent Pay

Don't forget! The school will be going cashless from September! Have you activated your account yet? It is really important that each pupil has an account for when school starts back in September. A ParentPay account enables parents to pay not only for school meals but for trips and other activities. If your child has free school meals / universal meals they will still need a ParentPay account to pay for trips etc.

Dinner Money

Texts have been sent out this week to parents who owe money for school meals. Should you have a debt for school meals this should be paid for via the ParentPay website before Thursday 16th July. If you have received a text and wish to query the amount then please get in touch with the school office who will be able to help you.
